DRESS CODE

The matter of suitable attire for golfing is a sensitive subject at all golf clubs. We wish that our members, visitors and guests enjoy their experience in AGC and respectfully request that golfers wear recognised golf attire. The appearance of clean and smart attire is expected on the course.

Awali Golf Club requests that everyone considers their attire in keeping with the spirit of suitable dress. If you are doubtful of any item, please refrain from wearing it to avoid any unnecessary embarrassment.

The following is a guideline:

On the course

<u>Acceptable</u>

- Polo shirt with collar or tops in keeping with golfing attire
- Ladies only are permitted sleeveless shirts
- Trousers/Shorts/Skirts must be tailored
- Flat soled footwear must be worn

NOT Acceptable on the Course

- Vests, round-neck T-shirts, sleeveless or collarless shirts
- Jeans, tracksuit bottoms, swim shorts, leggings, lycra, and sports shorts
- Shorts/skirts excessively tight or short in length
- Deep grooved, open or heeled footwear (including spikes or soft spikes)

In the Clubhouse

<u>Acceptable</u>

- Anything that is acceptable as course attire
- National Dress
- · Casual but reasonably smart attire
- Smart denims
- Sandals

NOT Acceptable

- Dress not acceptable on the course as shown above
- Scruffy/damaged attire or soiled working clothes
- Immodest clothing
- Hats/caps/visors, except where an event traditionally includes these: for example, the Christmas Hamper, the Ladies Excuse-Me. The usual penalty for non-compliance: buy a round of drinks for everyone in the Clubhouse.
